1. Purpose	Members support the purpose of the Association as defined in the statutes, actively or passively.	
2. General Provisions	Every individual person or legal entity wishing to support the Association can apply for individual or collective membership of the Association.	
3. Membership Categories	 Alumni Swiss higher level secondary schools (Sekundarstufe II) Compulsory education schools Sponsors SMEs, educational and industrial associations Companies & organisations 	
4. Rights and Duties 4.1 General	Every member of the Association has a single vote in the General Assembly. To cast this vote, the member must be physically present at the General Assembly. The vote is only transferable for collective memberships. All members of the Association will receive information on the activities of the Association first-hand at the General Assembly, in the annual financial report and newsletters. Active, committed Association members will have the option of helping to design and support the programmes as volunteers.	
4.2 Alumni	Former participants in YES programmes who are YES members are known as YES Alumni. Alumni members should be motivated to take part in Association activities in honorary positions. YES offers Alumni opportunities for networking and various events during the year.	
5. Becoming a Member	You can apply to become a member by filling out the online form on the home page. This membership application is binding. By submitting the form to apply to join, you undertake to acknowledge the statutes and the membership rules.	
6. Annual Contributions	 The annual contributions, graded by members. 7. Treatment of Members' Data	Members' data is only used for our own purposes and not passed on to third parties.	
8. Withdrawal	 Can be made at the end of every financial year (30.06.) The period of notice is 3 months and must therefore have been received in writing by 31.03. Members who are withdrawing are liable to pay contributions until the end of the period of notice; only afterwards will membership, together with the rights and duties it comprises, expire.
